Dear Sir,

I have been requested by several section holders at the Koitiate Domain (Turakins Beach) to draw your Council's attention to the state of the road from the end of the sealed portion to the beach.

At present this is in a very poor state: in several places the sand is showing through, and generally there is only a very thin coating of metal. Unless something is done before the Winter, the road will be in a bad state by then. It would appear that a good coating of metal is required over the whole length mentioned, so that it would consolidate before the wet weather comes. Mr. Connors has been approached by some sectionholders and will no doubt confirm this statement of the condition of the road.

In addition to those of us who only visit the beach periodically, there are some permanent residents now, which makes it more important that the road should be in a reasonable condition.

One other point which is still causing concern to some, is the erosion of the river just above the settlement: this was inspected about two years ago by some of your Council's officers, who at that time did not consider the position as requiring attention, but I am informed that some action may soon be needed.

The only other point I wish to make is that, some time ago I suggested that sectionholders be supplied with some kind of financial statement, but none has been forthcoming. If this is not possible, perhaps you could let me have the approximate position, and I would then be able to advise any who enquire as to the finances of the Domain Board.

The question of the erosion by the Turakina River, north of the settlement, is subject to periodical check by the County Engineer. He is of the opinion that no remedial action is yet required.

RANGITIKEI COUNTY COUNCIL

Notes of meeting held at Koitiata 13th April, 1968.

Meeting called by Koitiata Beach Section-holders at 10 a.m. at home of Mr. Huijs. Approximately 40 people present including Councillor Gordon and County Engineer. Chairman of Meeting - Mr. L.P. Anderson.

After Councillor Gordon outlined the Council's programmes for metalling the 2½ miles of road from the beach to the existing seal this financial year, a full discussion developed on possible improvements to the Koitiata Domain.

The following works were recommended to Council for action this year:-

1. Top course and seal of 40 chains of main road through the settlement.
2. Formation and metal 10 chains road access along beach frontage.
3. Formation of rubbish tip area.
4. Speed limit of 20 m.p.h. in Domain.

Other works mentioned:-

1. Public telephone
2. Street lighting
3. Public water supply (estimate)
4. River erosion west of township
5. Camping ground levelling and grassing
6. Tree planting
7. Improved access to river mouth.

The Meeting concluded at 12 noon.

The development of the Koitiata Domain for the next five years has been discussed by the Board and the section holders in the Domain settlement. The Rangitikei County as part of this year's works programme are reconstructing and metalling the remaining  $2\frac{1}{2}$  miles of gravel road giving access to the foreshore of the Domain. This work will be continued next year to include top course and seal of the road to the boundary of the housing settlement. There will then remain only  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile of gravel road through the township.

Development of the domain suggested:-

1. Top course and seal of 40 chain of main road
2. Metal and form 10 chain access road on beach front
3. Improved access to mouth of river
4. Level and grass approximately 10 acres as camping ground and picnic area on the Eastern side of the settlement
5. Tree planting
6. Public water supply.

During the current financial year it is proposed to:-

1. Seal 20 chain of the access road through the settlement
2. Level and grass the camping ground
3. Improve access to river mouth.

Would you please define the powers the Rangitikei County have in working on the Koitiata Domain and the works that we may spend the Domain funds upon. During the levelling of the camping area there will be a surplus of sand and the County would like to use this material for sand blasting some of the steel bridges in the area. Approximately 300 cubic yards are required. Is it necessary to obtain the Crown's permission to take the material?
